Tour Overview

Day 1 – Welcome to Cairo

Arrive at Cairo International Airport, where our VIP team will assist with entry formalities, luggage, and visa arrangements. Meet your private guide and driver before transferring to your hotel for check-in and relaxation.

Day 2 – Giza Pyramids, Sphinx & Saqqara

Explore the legendary Giza Plateau, with the option to step inside the Great Pyramid of Cheops (additional fee). Ride a camel across the desert sands for iconic photos, then descend to the mighty Sphinx. Continue to Memphis and Saqqara, where you'll enjoy lunch before visiting the Step Pyramid of Djoser and ancient tombs. Evening at leisure.

Day 3 – Egyptian Museum & Old Cairo

Begin at the Grand Egyptian Museum (upon full opening) or the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities, home to 160,000 artifacts including King Tutankhamun's treasures. After lunch at a famous Cairo restaurant, explore Old Coptic and Islamic Cairo: El Moez Street, Al Azhar Mosque, Bab Zuweila, the Hanging Church, Saint Sergius Church, and the Crypt of Jesus. Evening at leisure.

Day 4 – Aswan & Philae Temple

Fly to Aswan and visit the High Dam before sailing by motorboat to Philae Island to explore the Temple of Isis, beautifully relocated to preserve it from Nile floods. Board your luxury Nile cruise and settle into your cabin. In the afternoon, enjoy a private felucca ride around Kitchener Island and the Agha Khan Mausoleum. Overnight on the cruise.

Day 5 – Kom Ombo & Edfu Temples

Sail to Kom Ombo to explore its unique dual temple dedicated to Horus and Sobek, followed by the Crocodile Museum. Continue cruising to Edfu, where you'll ride by horse-drawn carriage to the Temple of Horus—Egypt's best-preserved temple. Sail overnight toward Luxor.

Day 6 – Valley of the Kings & Hatshepsut's Temple

Arrive in Luxor and cross to the West Bank to visit the Valley of the Kings, with entry to three royal tombs, including Tutankhamun's. Continue to the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut and the Colossi of Memnon before returning to your cruise for a relaxing evening.

Day 7 – Return to Cairo

After breakfast, disembark and transfer to Luxor Airport for your flight back to Cairo. Assistance with luggage and international departure provided.
