From the grand temples to hidden tombs and vibrant bazaars, this tour reveals the soul of Egypt's past and its living traditions.

Tour Overview

Day 1 - Welcome to Cairo

Arrive at Cairo International Airport, where our VIP team will assist with visas, luggage, and entry formalities. Transfer by private vehicle to your luxury hotel. Evening at leisure.

Day 2 - Pyramids, Sphinx & Saqqara

Meet your private Egyptologist guide for a full day at the Giza Plateau. Admire the Great Pyramid of Cheops (with the option to enter its burial chamber), enjoy a camel ride across the desert, and marvel at the Sphinx. After lunch, continue to Saqqara to see the Step Pyramid of Djoser and ancient tombs, followed by a visit to Memphis, the first capital of Egypt.

Day 3 - Egyptian Museum & Old Cairo

Tour the Egyptian Museum or Grand Egyptian Museum (upon opening), home to over 160,000 artifacts, including Tutankhamun's treasures. After lunch, explore Old Coptic and Islamic Cairo, including El Moez Street, Al Azhar Mosque, the Hanging Church, and the Crypt of Jesus. End the day at Khan el Khalili Bazaar before returning to your hotel.

Day 4 - Luxor: Karnak & Luxor Temples

Fly to Luxor and tour Karnak Temple, the largest religious complex of ancient Egypt, followed by Luxor Temple and the Avenue of the Sphinxes. Overnight in a luxury hotel in Luxor.

Day 5 - Dendera & Board Dahabeya

Visit Dendera's Temple of Hathor, renowned for its healing associations and astronomical ceiling. Return to Luxor, enjoy lunch, and board your Dahabeya. Evening at leisure on the Nile.

Day 6 - Valley of the Kings & Hatshepsut's Temple

Cross to the West Bank to explore three royal tombs in the Valley of the Kings, including Tutankhamun's. Visit Queen Hatshepsut's Temple and the Colossi of Memnon before returning to your Dahabeya for lunch. Begin sailing toward Edfu.

Day 7 - Edfu Temple

Ride by horse-drawn carriage to the Temple of Horus at Edfu, the best-preserved temple in Egypt. Return to the Dahabeya and continue sailing.

Day 8 - Kom Ombo Temple

Arrive at Kom Ombo to visit the dual temple dedicated to Sobek and Horus, followed by the Crocodile Museum. Continue sailing toward Aswan.

Day 9 - Aswan Highlights

Visit the High Dam and sail by motorboat to Philae Island to explore the Temple of Isis. Later, enjoy a private felucca ride around Kitchener Island and the Agha Khan Mausoleum. Final evening aboard your Dahabeya.

Day 10 - Departure

Disembark and transfer to Aswan Airport for your flight to Cairo. Assistance with luggage and onward international flight.
